Eligibility requirements for the Curling World Class Performance <u>Programme</u>

- 1.1 To be eligible for membership of the WCP, the Athlete must be eligible to compete for Great Britain at the Winter Olympic/ Paralympic Games and must therefore satisfy the eligibility requirements of the IOC, the IPC, the BOA or BPA, the World Curling Federation or the [international disabled sport federation (if any)] (as applicable), including (but not limited to) the criteria set out in Clause 1.2 below. Advice on eligibility requirements can be found in the WCP Athlete Handbook and is available from the Performance Director.
- 1.2 The Athlete shall immediately notify the WCP Performance Director should he or she at any time fail to satisfy any one or more of the criteria set out below:
 - (a) the Athlete shall satisfy the terms and conditions of eligibility and selection of the BOA or BPA (as appropriate) to represent Great Britain at the Games;
 - (b) the Athlete shall satisfy the World Curling Federation's eligibility code with respect to their ability to represent their National Teams;
 - (c) the Athlete must be a member of their relevant Home Nation NGB and must remain so during the Membership Period.
 - (d) the Athlete must not be serving a ban from competition as a result of being found guilty of a doping offence or be in receipt of a lifetime funding ban from UK Sport; and
 - the Athlete must not be serving a ban from competition as a result of being found guilty of an offence relating to betting, gambling or corruption;
 - (f) be in receipt of a funding ban from UK Sport;
 - (g) and
 - (h) meet any other criteria determined by the WCP and/or UK Sport for membership of the WCP from time to time.
